

Google Cardboard App – HELP (Android only)

QR Code Error: "Unrecognized QR Code"

Error: QR code is not recognized in the Android Google Cardboard App. Error message: Unrecognized QR Code. (Not a QR Code problem. Cardboard App has technical issues.)

Solution: Scan the QR code with a QR reader app and open the link in the Cardboard app.

First:

1) The Chrome browser must be set as your default browser on your smartphone.

On Samsung phones at: Settings -> APPS -> Default apps (top right menu) -> Browser App -> Chrome


- 2) The latest version of the Google Cardboard app must be installed.
- 3) The smartphone must have an Internet connection while the QR code is being scanned.


Install a QR Code Reader App


(Recommendation: QR Code Reader from Scan)






Android Settings: Change the settings of the Google Cardboard app, to open Cardboard Links in the Cardboard app.











QR Reader App: Scan QR code
